### *Holistic Tidbit*

**Did you know?** Digestion is a slow job in a horse's intestines, because grass is such a difficult food to digest. A horse's intestines are an average of 70 feet long. The food moves through the intestines at an average rate of 1 foot per minute. Grass and loose hay take slightly longer to travel than grain or pelleted hay.

### **Cindy's winter time favorite: Fastrack**

Horses are stalled up more in the winter with little or no access to grass. Eating more dry hay, drinking less water, and sudden temperature change all contribute to the increase possibility of stress and colic.

**Fastback** breaks everything down into a readily available form inside the gut where nutrient absorption takes place.

Fastback provides enzymes, probiotics, and yeast to the gut which allows your horse to utilize the feeding program you have him on better. It boosts the immune system for a healthier happier horse. And is a preventive for colic due to impaction.
